Wednesday evenings in July Mayfield Congregational United Church of Christ in Sycamore joined with First Congregational United Church of Christ in DeKalb to bring a summer Bible program for kids. Basing our activities on an animal theme, we learned what the Bible has to say about diversity, getting along with others, and working together for the common good. We enjoyed skits, songs, games, snacks, and crafts. Each week a special guest shared knowledge of animals. Hoo Haven brought a red-tailed hawk, two corn snakes, and a rat. Diana Swanson taught us about birds and provided binoculars for sighting. Lars Carlson explained about bees (did you know it takes 12 bees working their entire lives to produce just one teaspoon of honey?!). And Hayden Aves brought a two-month-old calf to visit - a much anticipated finale to our program.

Traditionally at Bible School programs the ratio of adults to kids is low. Not so for our Wednesdays in the Waystation. Parents stayed, both church's pastors attended, two adults from each church assisted, teen volunteers helped. Everyone was relaxed, interested, and having a great time. The adults left the "real world" behind and allowed their authentic selves to run free. Their lights were shining brightly on their inmost selves (to borrow the words from Proverbs) and it was a joy to see.

I am looking forward to our 2023 summer Bible program, one that we plan to intentionally design as intergenerational. Apparently, we all need a chance to reconnect with our inner child and most authentic selves. Until next summer rolls around, I hope you will join us at Sunday worship, Wednesday night Bible Study, and our events each month.

The Sondra King Memorial CROP Walk of N. DeKalb County returns! Mayfield UCC has been active with this in the past, and Dawn Carlson notes that Mayfield was one of the founding churches for the ORIGINAL Crop walk in this area. This year's chair provided this information: "Crop Project began in 1947 when farmers were asked to donate food and seed crops to our hungry neighbors in post-World War II Europe and Asia. The first CROP Hunger Walks took place in Bismarck, North Dakota (1969), and York, Pennsylvania (1970). Since then, CROP Hunger Walk events have been held in hundreds of communities, large and small, raising millions of dollars to eradicate hunger and poverty. The Dekalb community has been participating in the CROP walk for over 50 years raising over \$470,000 to help alleviate hunger in our community and around the world. In 2021 we raised over \$20,000 putting us in the top 100 CROP walks for amount fundraised. And 25% of money fundraised each year stays in our community to help local projects and non-profits stay funded."


