let your light shine before others Nehemiah 9:12

What is the first thing you notice when you meet someone? Their smile, their eyes, what they say, their tone of voice, body language, what they are wearing? The staff at Psychology Today note that "first impressions are influenced by a number of factors, such as facial shape, vocal inflection, attractiveness, and general emotional state. People tend to get attached to their initial impressions of others and find it very difficult to change their opinion, even when presented with lots of evidence to the contrary." 1

In the Gospel of Matthew, you will find Jesus teaching in chapters five, six, and seven. One of the things he says is, "In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to God in heaven" (Matt. 5:16). I think we can paraphrase this as: act nice so you make a good first impression. Do you carry yourself in a way that radiates care for others, happiness, or interest in those you meet? Does an angry or grumpy attitude shine through? I think I'll be a little more careful with any first impressions I give now that I know people are unlikely to ever change their opinions of me! Every day we have many chances to make a first impression. How wonderful would it be if we were able to consistently "let our light shine" to those we meet, so much so that they asked us how we can be so happy? (or positive? or calm? or forgiving?) and we could reply my religious beliefs help. And then invite them to come to church with you to meet more friendly people.

Go shine, my friends. Go shine!



Reports from Council meeting – July 2023

Sophia Varcados, Moderator and Cary Hansen, Deacon

Pastor (absent) - moderator reported: Time report was submitted. Upcoming events and worship themes were presented and reviewed. Christian Ed resumes for children on Sept 10, adult Bible study resumes Sept. 6. Second Sundays adult bible school is being added.

Deacons: Request for new paraments for the altar and discussion about COVID levels.

Trustees: Various maintenance items around the church discussed and projects completed. Septic tank was drained and repairs were made to the parsonage. Tree management is being discussed.

Stewardship: Mayfield Preservation Fund report was given. Quilt raffle plans are in the works, Sept. 20 - Nov. 19. Request for volunteers.

Treasurer: Up-to-date budget was presented, accounts were discussed.

Moderator: Event planning and staffing were discussed.

Clerk: For the month of July, an estimate of 6.5 people watched remotely, with another 30.5 views. We averaged 19.8 people a week attending service. Discussion of upcoming honors for years of church membership.
