



Reports from the Council meeting - December 2023 Diane Hance, Clerk

Pastor: Time report was submitted. Upcoming events and worship themes were presented and reviewed. Pastor Lauri will be on vacation Mon Feb 5 through Sun Feb 11. December Toys for Tots Gift Wrapping took place with 2,000 children served. Asking Mayfield members to watch for sales after Christmas of bow and wrapping paper for next year KIDS Sunday School begins Jan 7 and we are in need to volunteer teachers and helpers. Second Sundays Adult Sunday School resumes Jan 14. Zoom Bible Study on Wednesday Evenings continues with Diana Swanson.

Deacons reported that Christmas preparations are truly in the works. Dawn thanked the hard, dedicated work of Deacons Wilma and Cary – their 2 year term ends in the new year. A brunch will be held after the New Year's Eve morning service.

Trustees: Various maintenance items around the church discussed and projects completed. Video doorbell was installed at the parsonage. Battery sump pump backup will be installed at the church and parsonage.

Stewardship: Rita expressed thankfulness for a true team effort which raised \$14,413 since May 29 – the kick off of the preservation fund. At present, Donations - \$11,020; Spare Change - \$367; Raffle - \$2505; Pumpkin hats - \$95 and Pies - \$426.

Treasurer: CD: \$104,237.49 - Checking: \$11,814.70 - Original Savings: \$40,338.03 - Restricted Savings Account - \$5,842.75. Insurance will go up 10%. Water sensors will be placed Dec. 21. We do not need internet service to comply with insurance needs for the water sensor. A cell signal is good enough. Council tabled getting "internet Service for the church" at this time. It was voted proceed with establishing Quickbook on-line and migration.

Moderator Jan Wylde and Sue Goudy are on the nominating committee for 2024. Annual Church Meeting set for Jan 28, 2024. Council reports will be needed and notification of thismeeting will be presented in church, newsletter, email and snail mail.

Clerk: Attendance averages for November 2023. In-person – 25.5; Sunday School – 1; Facebook Live – 6.5. Total membership 80.
