**Pastor**: Time report submitted. Updates on her paths to "Alternate Path to Ordination". Mayfield, 1st Congregational and Federated will hosted 2 weeks discussion on Christian Nationalism. Prairie Association fall meeting was canceled due to low sign-up but Cluster Meetings were attended by Pastor and Diane Hance. IL Conference will be attended via Zoom by Pastor and Diane on Nov. 2. Salvation Army Christmas Toy wrapping will take place Dec 17 & 18. Salvation Army will not be getting toys from Toys for Tots this year.

Christian Education: Sunday School has begun.

Advent will include an Inter-generational SS lead by Pastor and an Advent Bible Study on Wed. evening via Zoom.
